

### **Dr Peter Clayton**



Peter is an experienced analytical scientist by training and experience. Since 2005 he has been employed at British American Tobacco's R&D facility in Southampton as a Technical Specialist scientist within the analytical function. Subsequently he changed roles and became a scientist running projects supporting E-cigarettes and non-combustible products. This has augmented his analytical science capabilities with knowledge of harm-reduction and nicotine-delivery products.

Prior to employment in the tobacco industry, Dr Clayton fulfilled roles within the Pharmaceutical Industry and Contract Research sector where he was involved with Drug Discovery and Bio-analytical measurements. Preceding this he worked in academia as a Post-doctoral Research Worker at two leading UK universities. During this combined period he co-authored 23 journal publications, five of which as lead author, as well as making presentations at international scientific gatherings.

Since 2013 he has been an 'ordinary' member of the Executive Committee of the Chromatographic Society where he plays a role in the organisation of some of the society's meetings and in securing membership benefits.
